

Authorship by Origination: A Constitutional Definition of Human-Directed AI Composition

Under decaying industrial paradigms, traditional publishing houses, academic editorial boards, and corporate conglomerates operate not as engines of truth, but as **control structures for communication**. - **The Transformation:** Decades later, that same "jungle music" permeates global infrastructure, completely rewriting the lexicon of modern culture, commerce, and media.
- **The Parallel:** Just as establishment gatekeepers once attempted to delegitimize hip-hop through derogatory classification, modern academic and corporate entities attempt to delegitimize human-directed AI composition. They label cognitive architecture as "theft" or "automation" because it threatens their historical monopoly on intellectual validation.

C. Empirical Evidence: The Plagiarism Metric and False Positives

An empirical examination of institutional control systems is revealed through academic verification metrics. **99% of my personal papers (specifically at Colorado Technical University that deployed this system), returned a 0% plagiarism rate.**

- **The Anomaly:** The minimal flagged percentages never targeted the body of content, the conceptual arguments, or the structural narrative. Instead, flags were triggered exclusively by common terms within titles or meta-descriptors—sometimes overlapping with previous works by the author themselves.
