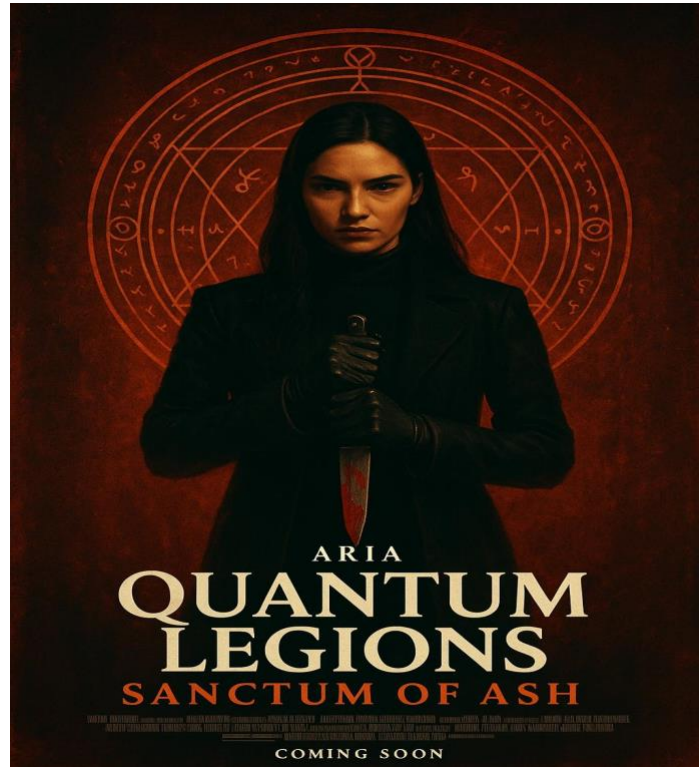


Quantum Legions: Sanctum of Ash

Core Narrative
